MRAS Junior Rodeo Fun Series Rules and Policies

Arena Access & Parking

- a) Riders must bring their **own** horses (no horses will be supplied by the group).
- b) One horse, one rider per participant fee.
- c) Fun Series participants have access to the arena ONLY during scheduled dates and times.
- d) No riding outside of the arena.
- e) Parking is limited to the parking lots north of the arena, NO parking trailers on the roadways.
- f) Please clean up manure, shavings, hair, etc. in the arena and around your trailers. Do NOT leave a mess for others to clean. Lighting is limited in the parking area. Suggestion to bring headlamp.

Conduct & Safety

- g) The ring stewart/gate keeper decisions must be adhered to.
- h) Properly fitted riding helmets (ASTM/SEI certified) are mandatory for all riders.
- i) Appropriate serviceable tack required, western saddle and humane type of bit (excluding wire or other metal device), no hackamores may be checked by ring stewart/gate keeper before entry into the arena.
- j) NO restrictive or securing devices to saddles (i.e. Velcro fasteners) are allowed.
- k) Western style boots with heels required.
- I) NO split reins during rides, split reins MUST be tied together.
- m) Lead line participants are led from the ground ONLY, not from horse back.
- n) Rider safety and control are critical. Riders who do not have control of their mounts will be asked to dismount and leave the arena.
- o) Safety in staging/grooming area(s):
 - Parents are expected to monitor their children while mounted and not mounted.
 - Unattended horses are not allowed in the arena. "Extra" or multiple mounts can be tied at trailer until required in the arena.
- p) Red ribbons are required on the tails of horses that kick. Horses that kick should be situated with their butts to the wall or tied outside.
- q) Unnecessary roughness or abuse of animals will not be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave the arena and MRAS grounds.

Participation

- r) The Series will follow the Alberta High School Rodeo Rules (as closely as possible)
- s) Participants who miss their name being announced or are not in the arena at the start of their run will be given a "No Time".
- t) If you are unable to attend any evenings, please email JRrodeo@mras-track.com in advance so order changes can be made in advance.

General

- u) Riding permitted ONLY during activity time.
- v) NO riding in market areas or campgrounds.
- w) NO SMOKING in or near the MRAS buildings.
- x) NO DOGS or PETS allowed in riding areas (entire arena).
- y) NO ALCOHOL or DRUGS permitted on premises without a license.

Junior Rodeo Participant Code of Conduct

MRAS is committed to responsible animal care and treatment. Our animal care program is based on guidelines for animal care at public events developed by the Canadian Association of Fairs and Exhibitions (CAFÉ). This Code of Conduct outlines what is expected of Junior Rodeo participants with respect to the handling and use of horses involved in activities at MRAS facilities.

- a) Horses must be transported to and from MRAS facilities in accordance with all humane transport regulations and standards. More information can be found at: https://inspection.canada.ca/animal-health/terrestrial-animals/humane-transport/livestock-and-poultry-transport-in-canada/eng/1363748532198/1363748620219
- b) Loading and unloading must be undertaken using proper equipment and procedures.
- c) All horses must be treated and handled in a responsible manner. The well-being of the horses shall take precedence over the demands of owners, organizers, sponsors, and officials.
- d) The care of all horses must be as consistent as possible with their normal schedules and standards. High standards of nutrition, health, sanitation, environment, and safety must be met all times. All handling, housing and veterinary treatment must ensure adequate animal care.
- e) Horses should be prepared with proper training, fitting, and grooming prior to the activity. Excessive discipline of horses at the activity is unacceptable.
- f) Riding members are expected to provide adequate training for anyone handling their horses. Untrained individuals, including MRAS personnel and visitors, should not be permitted to handle horses or equipment.
- g) Junior Rodeo participants should take every opportunity to enhance public awareness, education and appreciation of proper horse management and handling practices.

There will be no tolerance of any mistreatment of horses. Any unacceptable conduct will be subject to action, including possible elimination from the activity at the discretion of the Animal Care Committee.
