IF YOU WANT TO IMPROVE YOUR REINING SKILLS THIS IS THE PERFECT CLINIC FOR YOU! RIDERS WILL RIDE TWICE A DAY IN A GROUP OF FOUR TO FIVE RIDERS WITH A BREAK IN BETWEEN RIDES. CIRCLES, SPEED CONTROL, SPINS, STOPS WILL BE WORKED ON AND THEN PUT IT ALL TOGETHER INTO A REINING PATTERN.
