



## WORKING EQUITATION EASE OF HANDLING (EOH) OBSTACLES PRACTICE AT MRAS

Working Equitation Ease of Handling Obstacles are executed with control, finesse, and precision through a designated course. The MRAS EOH practice will allow riders with experience to practice at their preferred WE level and introduce new riders to the EOH obstacles.

### Format:

- First group arrival at 9:30am, all riders will help set up the course; approx. 10-11 EOH obstacles.
- Following set up, ½ hour for group practice on the obstacles - **NO CANTERING BETWEEN OBSTACLES DURING GROUP PRACTICE.**
- Each rider will have an opportunity to ride the course. If time permits, an additional course run or practice time.
- Course tear down by all second group participants.
